LADIES' EVENING BIBLE STUDY

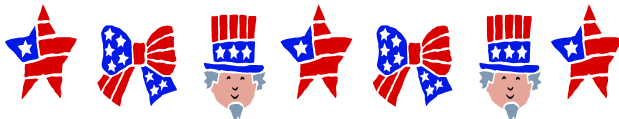
The Ladies' Evening Bible Study class has begun. They meet every Wednesday evening at 6:30 p.m. If you have questions, please contact Jerry Montgomery.
