CUB SCOUT NEWS

Cub Scouting began in 1930 as a younger-boys program of the Boy Scouts of America, created to give boys ages 8–10 a fun, age-appropriate introduction to Scouting's values of character, citizenship, and personal fitness. Inspired by earlier British “Wolf Cub” programs, it emphasized learning through games, crafts, outdoor activities, and family involvement rather than the more advanced skills of Boy Scouting. Over the decades, Cub Scouting evolved to reflect changing families and communities, adding new ranks, uniforms, and activities while keeping its core ideals rooted in the Scout Oath and Law. Today, Cub Scouting serves youth of both genders in kindergarten through fifth grade, continuing its mission of building character, leadership, and a love of service through adventure and teamwork.
